**Please bring a snack to share.**


**\*Board Meeting, March 2, 11am, East Hall of Sundial Recreation Center\***

## Work of Palo Verde Artist in WVAM Exhibit

Palo Verde Artist Lupe Cavanaugh had her painting, "Handsome in Red Bridle" accepted at the West Valley Art Museum (WVAM) 2020 Celebration of Artists, a juried art exhibit that showcases the



talents of Arizona artists and is open to the public. Exhibition dates are March 9 – April 30, 2020, with a catered awards reception on March 12, 4 – 6pm. This year's awards include one each: Best of Show, Mayor's Award, Trustees' Award and First Place, Second Place, Third Place and Honorable Mention Awards for each of the following categories: Painting, Drawing, Mixed Media and Photography. Cash awards for Best of Show and First Places will be given (minimum of 15 juried pieces). Juror for Celebration of Artists 2020 is Robert Panzer, Director of Arts Education, Peoria Unified School District.

Paintings previously entered in the Palo Verde show are not eligible; however, paintings previously entered in the All Sun City Show are eligible. At the discretion of the judge, first, second, third, and honorable mention ribbons will be given for each skill level within each of the categories. There will be a Judge's Choice ribbon and a People's Choice ribbon awarded. Voting for People's Choice will close at 2 PM on Saturday, March 21. Entry cards and show rules for entering are available at the Palo Verde Art Room.
