



#### **VELVET TETRAULT, ARTIST OF THE MONTH - MARCH 2022**


Velvet has been painting for 45 years and has always loved colors. She began by making images on linoleum and printing them. By the age of 19, she became enthralled with realistic Science Fiction art, and her first paintings on canvas were people

from science fiction she had written.

Besides taking college art courses, Velvet studied hundreds of art books and instructional videos, taking many workshops taught by established artists and attending conventions learning many artistic techniques and styles. She painted diverse subjects such as florals, landscapes, still life, birds, animals, fantasy, and people.







She began painting birds in 2017, then florals and scrolls.
