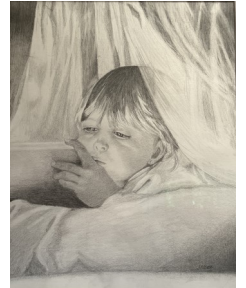


ARTIST of the MONTH
